

MEMORY VERSE FOR THE UNFOLDING MYSTERY (2017-18)

Lesson 79 (Ex 19.5-6, to be recited September 20, 2017)

Memory Verse “Now therefore, if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession among all peoples, for all the earth is mine; 6 and you shall be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.”

Lesson 80 (Ps 24.3-4, to be recited September 27, 2017)

Memory Verse Who may ascend into the hill of the LORD? And who may stand in His holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to falsehood, And has not sworn deceitfully.

Lesson 81 (Intro to 10 Commandments, to be recited October 11, 2017)

Memory Verse Then God spoke all these words, saying, “I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.”

Lesson 82 (1st Commandment, to be recited October 18, 2017)

Memory Verse You shall have no other gods before Me.

Lesson 83 (2nd Commandment, to be recited October 25, 2017)

Memory Verse You shall not make for yourself an idol, or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth. You shall not worship them or serve them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me, but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.

Lesson 84 (3rd Commandment, to be recited November 8, 2017)

Memory Verse You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not leave him unpunished who takes His name in vain.

Lessons 85 & 86 (4th Commandment, Ex 20.8-11, to be recited November 29 and December 13, 2017)

Memory Verse Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days you shall labor and do your work, but the seventh day is a sabbath of the LORD your God; in it you shall not do any work, you or your son or your daughter, your male or your female servant or your cattle or your sojourner who stays with you. For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day; therefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day and made it holy.

Lesson 87 (4th Commandment, Mt 11.28-30, to be recited January 10, 2018)

Memory Verse Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you, and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart; and YOU SHALL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS. For My yoke is easy, and my load is light.

Lesson 88 (4th Commandment, Hb 4.9-11, to be recited January 17, 2018)

Memory Verse There remains therefore a Sabbath rest for the people of God. For the one who has entered His rest has himself also rested from his works, as God did from His. Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall through following the same example of disobedience.

Lesson 89 (5th Commandment, Ex 20.12, to be recited January 24, 2018)

Memory Verse Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the LORD your God gives you.

Lesson 90 (5th Commandment, Eph 6.1-2, to be recited January 31, 2018)

Memory Verse Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.
 HONOR YOUR FATHER AND YOUR MOTHER
 (which is the first commandment with a promise),
 THAT IT MAY BE WELL WITH YOU, AND THAT YOU MAY LIVE LONG ON THE EARTH.
